OR (ii) First Class M.VSc/ M.Tech in Microbiology/ Public Health/Biotechnology/Epidemiology / Livestock Products Technology/ Biomedical Sciences/ Bio-Engineering/ Food Science/ Food Technology or allied discipline.

Desirable: NET/GATE qualification. Knowledge of computer applications including web-searching, MS-Office and report writing

Emoluments: Rs. 31,000/- PM + HRA (as per Central Govt. norms).

Age Limit: 30 years (relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/Women as Govt. Norms)

Duration of the Project: Likely up to Dec., 2022.
